The T Bar 3 is a 70+ acre lifestyle ranch located on highly acclaimed Wilson Mesa and just 25 minutes from the world renowned Telluride Ski Resort. The centerpiece of the T Bar 3 is a brand new, custom built, 5-bedroom, 5 bath home with an anticipated completion date of December 2022. The home's knoll-top location is accentuated by unobstructed 360 degree mountain views, from Wilson Peak and Mt. Wilson, to the Dolores Range and Little Cone, all the way to the San Sophia Ridge and Telluride Ski Resort. With reclaimed and historic finish materials dating back to the 1880's, the home is a combination of rustic elegance and a modern yet refined contemporary aesthetic.

Multiple walls of floor to ceiling glass and steel encapsulate the indoor/outdoor liveability, intentionally designed to compliment the home's National-Park-like setting. Meticulously designed for the utmost in modern western lifestyle, the home boasts a 4,250s.f. main house, 730s.f. garage, 960s.f. barn and 1183s.f. of outdoor patio space. An open kitchen, dining, and massive great room flows seamlessly into the fully integrated outdoor patio, equipped with beverage center, built-in grill, indoor/outdoor fireplace and hot tub. Every aspect of the home is scrupulously positioned to maximize views and soak in dramatic mesa-top sunsets. Two contiguous, but separate 35.1 acre parcels (1050 Posey Rd. and 973 Posey Rd.), each with separate wells and septic systems, create the flexibility of owning a multi-generational family compound. The surrounding Elk Creek Road, Fall Creek Road and Silver Pick Road are all maintained year round by San Miguel County.


RECREATION & WILDLIFE
